

## Etiquette.

**The G.N.A.S. rules state that:**

### **A Good Archer.**

1. Does not talk in a loud voice whilst others are shooting.
2. Does not talk to another competitor who obviously prefers to be silent.
3. Does not make any exclamation on the shooting line, which might disconcert a neighbour in the act of shooting.
4. Does not go behind the target to retrieve his arrows before his score has been recorded.
5. Does not walk up and down the shooting line comparing scores.
6. Does not touch anyone's equipment without permission.
7. Does not leave litter.
8. When calling scores does so in groups of three, for example 7-7-5' pause '5-5-3'.
9. If he breaks another's arrow through his own carelessness, he offers to pay for it.
10. Thanks the Target Captain at the end of each round for work on his behalf.
11. Turns off mobile phones while shooting or sets the phone to silent.

## Archers Responsibilities.

1. All archers must pay G.N.A.S., Club and Shooting Fees, when they become due. Any Archer who is in arrears of payment of their G.N.A.S. Fees will not be allowed to shoot at the Club facilities.
2. It is the responsibility of each archer to submit to the Club Records Officer details of each round shot indoors and outdoors to enable the handicap records to be kept up to date.
3. All archers are expected to assist at organised Club Functions (Have-A-Goes, working weekends, tournaments etc) whenever possible.
4. Every archer is required to comply with the Rules of the Club in force at that time.
5. Should you require any assistance on any aspect of equipment, or help with your shooting, then please contact any of the Club Coaches.
6. Should you want to bring any topic to the attention of the Committee for action, then please notify any member of the Committee, who will bring the matter to the next Committee meeting
